

Brookville Board of Park Trustees
Regular Meeting
August 13, 2024

The Regular Meeting of the Brookville Board of Park Trustees was called to order by President Blevins at 7:30 p.m. on August 13, 2024 in the City Council Chambers. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Trustees Cordes, Haney and Wilson; Manager Kuntz and Clerk Duncan were present. Council Liaison Fowler was absent.

Roll call by President Blevins.

Motion by Cordes, second by Wilson to approve the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Haney, second by Wilson to approve the July 9, 2024 Regular Meeting Minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Kuntz reported park permits are at \$33,737.50 this year through the month of July. The city has received \$1,010.00 in donations year-to-date.

Manager Kuntz thanked the Chamber of Commerce and the Park Board for all of their work toward the 73rd Annual Brookville Community Picnic. It was a great event that was well attended.

Manager Kuntz reported that City Council recently adopted legislation prohibiting the use of marijuana in the city parks. Signage will soon be posted throughout the parks.

Manager Kuntz reported the installation of the new inclusive playground at Golden Gate Park is complete. A sidewalk will be installed by our service department to increase accessibility to the new playground.

Trustee Cordes had no report.

Trustee Haney had no report.

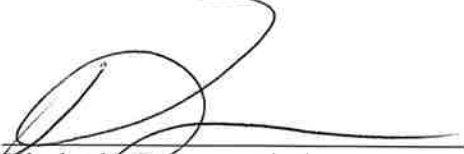
Trustee Wilson inquired if the date has been set for Ghostly Night Out and suggested closing the road to the castle playground during the event.
