

Brookville Board of Park Trustees
Regular Meeting
November 12, 2024

The Regular Meeting of the Brookville Board of Park Trustees was called to order by President Blevins at 7:30 p.m. on November 12, 2024 in the City Council Chambers. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Trustees Ledford and Wilson; Council Liaison Fowler, Manager Kuntz and Clerk Duncan were present.

Roll call by President Blevins.

Motion by Wilson, second by Ledford to approve the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Wilson, second by Ledford to approve the October 8, 2024 Regular Meeting Minutes as presented. Wilson yea, Leford abstained, Blevins yea. Motion carried with two yeas and one abstention.

President Blevins announced that Bonnie Cordes and Carolyn Haney have resigned and thanked them for their years of service. President Blevins welcomed new Trustee Jared Ledford to Park Board.

Manager Kuntz thanked former Trustees Cordes and Haney for their years of service on Park Board.

Manager Kuntz reported donations are at \$1,510 year-to-date compared to \$15,720 in 2023. Park permits are at \$48,406 year-to-date compared to \$45,077 this same time last year.

Manager Kuntz asked if Park Board would like to use a QR code for donations to the Christmas in the Park event. Manager Kuntz suggested if Park Board is interested, they could possibly partner with the Brookville Chamber of Commerce to use their non-profit account.

Trustee Ledford stated he appreciates the opportunity to serve and is looking forward to serving on Park Board. Trustee Ledford thanked former Trustees Cordes and Haney for their service.

Trustee Wilson stated she has appreciated working with former Trustees Cordes and Haney and stated she will miss utilizing their knowledge.

President Blevins stated Park Board is looking for someone to fill the open seat on Park Board as soon as possible.

President Blevins went over the schedule for Christmas in the Park event. Park Board will use Shelter 3 for set up and light testing. The kick-off date is set for December 6, 2024.

General discussion followed regarding setting up the electric panels, speakers or an FM station for broadcasting music during the event, and addressing letters to Santa that kids place in the mailbox at the park.
