

Brookville Board of Park Trustees
Regular Meeting
June 10, 2025

The Regular Meeting of the Brookville Board of Park Trustees was called to order by President Blevins at 7:30 p.m. on June 10, 2025 in the City Council Chambers. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Trustees Ledford and Wilson; Council Liaison Fowler, Manager Kuntz, and Clerk Duncan were present. Trustee Copley was absent.

Roll Call by President Blevins.

Motion by Ledford, second by Wilson to accept the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Wilson, second by Ledford to accept the May 13, 2025 Meeting Minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Kuntz reported park permits are at \$29,217.50 year-to-date and park donations remain at \$100 for 2025.

Manager Kuntz reported he hopes to have the T-Mobile Hometown Grant finalized by the first of next week. The CDBG funding to improve the sidewalks the Leiber Center has been approved. The Boy Scouts have requested that we hold off on a NatureWorks Grant application for the amphitheater project in order to work out more project details.

Manager Kuntz reported staff is gathering estimates for some resurfacing work at Golden Gate Park.

President Blevins inquired whether plans are being made to add more parking.


Manager Kuntz replied we created an additional 50 parking spaces near the t-ball fields this spring with asphalt grindings.

Trustee Ledford had no report.

Trustee Wilson had no report.

President Blevins commented the parks look good and many people are out enjoying them.
