

Brookville Board of Park Trustees  
Regular Meeting  
April 14, 2026

The Regular Meeting of the Brookville Board of Park Trustees was called to order by President Blevins at 7:30 p.m. on April 14, 2026 in the City Council Chambers. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Trustee Copley; Council Liaison Fowler, Manager Kuntz and Clerk Duncan were present. Trustees Hunt and Wilson were absent.

Sue Hey, 4204 Southridge Ct, Englewood, Ohio, presented a request to hold a "Cruisin for a Cause" event at Golden Gate Park on July 9, 2026 from 3:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. The event is part of a summer camp for kids called Camp Independence 2026. The Corvette Club will give free rides to the kids attending, followed by food and fun in the park. Ullery's Ice Cream will be there with ice cream for the campers.

President Blevins advised Park Board will vote on this event at the May meeting when they have a quorum present.

Manager Kuntz gave an update on the Kiwanis Club little library project.

Manager Kuntz reported some of the benches at Westbrook park have been repaired by the Service Department. The owners of the old Melody Pool location have offered some picnic tables to the city, which will be placed at Gruenig Park for seating during the Third Thursday events.

Manager Kuntz reported the Memorial Tree and memory bench program is still going strong. Two memorial trees and a bench were ordered in the last month.

Manager Kuntz reported he recently met with the boy scouts and they picked a location for the bike repair station project.

Manager Kuntz reported the CDBG sidewalk project at Golden Gate Park will be underway soon.

President Blevins stated the skate park needs to be sprayed for weeds and there are some tree branches at Ward Park that look like they are about to fall.


Manager Kuntz stated he will have the Service Department address both items.
