

Brookville Board of Park Trustees
Regular Meeting
December 8, 2020

The Regular Meeting of the Brookville Board of Park Trustees was called to order by President Cordes at 7:30 p.m. on December 8, 2020 in the City Council Chambers. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Trustees Blevins, Haney and Vance; Council Liaison Fowler, Clerk Duncan and Manager Keaton were present.

Manager Keaton reported it was an amazing walk through the park on Friday night and expressed her appreciation to Park Board for all the work they put in to make the event a success. Manager Keaton reported she is looking into installing a permanent fixture for donations.

Manager Keaton wished everyone a Merry Christmas and a happy and safe New Year.

Trustee Haney thanked President Cordes for coordinating the Christmas in the Park Event. Trustee Haney also thanked the City and the Service Department for their help with the event as well.

Manager Keaton reported the 200 goody bags were distributed in 28 minutes.

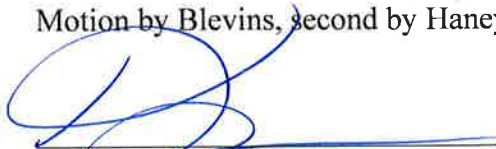
